	3. Exclamation point icon indicates there is something that needs to be altered, in this case, sections of feedback. Again, clicking blue link will lead to appropriate page
	4. Exclamation point icon indicates there is something that needs to be altered, in this case, scoring disparity. Clicking the blue link will lead to the specific section with the scoring disparity. Clicking question mark icon will give a tooltip.

	9. Submit button at the bottom once peer reviewer is done, with confirmation afterwards to work around false-submits.

Technical Details	11. Full answers for each category of the application will be listed, to give peer reviewers access to give their feedback
	12. On the right side, a feedback section will be populated with (triggers?) for responses from the peer reviewers

	13. Submit Feedback button at the bottom of the page to enable the saving of feedback, which can be edited later 14. The scores that are indicated on each of the individual proposal sections are the same as the ones that are shown on the Home page for the proposal
Disparate Scores	15. Exclamation point icon appears in 2nd level navigation bar to bring attention to disparate scores
	16. Parts of the specific section will be highlighted and commented upon, much like Google Documents, to allow peer reviewers to comment and discuss feedback and scoring
	17. An example showing a peer reviewer tagging an OCHIS Admin staff member for clarification, etc.
	18. Review My Scores button will lead back to the full section page to allow for altering feedback and scores after discussing with other peer reviewers
